Dr. David Akopian is an Associate Professor at the University of Texas at San Antonio (UTSA). Prior to joining UTSA, he was a Senior Scientist with Nokia Corporation from 1999 to 2003. He was a member of teaching and research staff of Tampere University of Technology (1993-1999). From 1998 to 1999 he was the coordinator of the Tampere International Centre of Signal Processing (TICSP).

Dr. David Akopian received M.Sc. degree from the Moscow Institute of Physics and Technology (PhysTech), USSR, in 1987 and Ph.D. degree from the Tampere University of Technology (TUT), Finland, EU, in 1997, in electrical engineering. His current research interests include digital signal processing algorithms for communication and navigation systems, dedicated platforms and accelerators and mobile applications. Dr. Akopian's work was supported by the Finnish Academy of Sciences, Nokia, US National Science Foundation, US National Institutes of Health, US AF Research Laboratory, US Navy, Texas Educational Board, etc. He authored about 30 patents and more than 100 publications.
